Academic Programme

The College offers a wide range of subject choices. Students choose a course of study based on their interests, abilities, and their future career direction.

Nayland College is renowned for its outdoor education and marine biology programmes. Because of our location we can offer world class activities and real-world experiences in three National Parks (**Abel Tasman**, **Kahurangi** and **Nelson Lakes**), rivers, seas, beaches and mountains that surround Nayland College.

Other subjects that are offered include: psychology, photography, dance, drama, music, hospitality, digital design, design and visual communication, painting, a range of technology subjects, fashion and design, biology, chemistry, physics, geography, history, business studies, economics, sociology, mathematics, Māori and many more...

Our NCEA results are outstanding at all levels and every year many students excel in New Zealand Scholarship examinations and gain tertiary study awards. Our students also excel in Trinity and Associated Board music and performing arts exams.

Other activities occur outside class time and after school, such as: dance and drama clubs, theatre sports, orchestra, choirs, jazz, rock and concert bands, the environment club, debating and Journalism to mention some of them.

Many sports are also offered after school, including: football, volleyball, rugby, basketball, ultimate frisbee, futsal, netball, tennis to mention just a few.

International Programme

Our experienced International Student programme hosts a balanced intake from the Americas, Asia and Europe.

Our extensive orientation programme helps new students to adjust to a New Zealand school and to their homestay family.

ESOL teachers provide an intensive English language programme and academic English and Cambridge English.
